In times of natural disasters, including hurricanes, floods, earthquakes, and wildfires like those in Maui, The WASH Foundation, an evolution of Clean the World Foundation, partners with local organizations to help provide affected communities with hygiene supplies, access to clean water, and additional essential supplies.



During these emergencies, there is often an increase in infectious diseases due to the crowding of displaced peoples, potential inadequate water and sanitation, and limited access to healthcare. [i] As a method of prevention and control, it is suggested that primary healthcare delivery and proper water, sanitation, and hygiene be prioritized.
